Message from the League's New Communications Coordinator



Dear Friends and Colleagues,

*This past January, after two valuable members of the Board of Directors stepped down from their positions, the Detroit League's Board began reorganizing, most notably involving the position of President. The new organizational structure follows an effort led by the Marquette League, which breaks out the President position functions into: **Communications Coordinator, Convener, and League Liaison**. In March, the Board appointed members to temporarily serve in these positions.*

*At the Detroit League's **Annual Membership Meeting**, scheduled for **Saturday, June 22nd**, the new Board structure will be proposed as an amendment to the Detroit League's By-Laws and elections will be held to permanently fill these new positions, along with other Board positions. 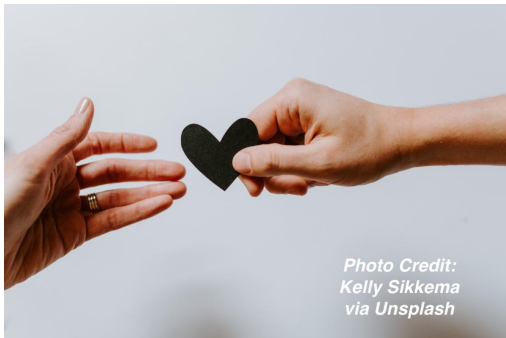
